**Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

Requires Oregon Health Authority to request specified information from potential contractors and, if certain conditions are met, to request proposals to establish and operate systems and technologies designed to detect and prevent improper payments in state medical assistance program.

Public Hearing

SB 490

Requires entity advertising and providing specified health services to provide notices and disclosures about nature o services.

SB 630

Provides for licensing and regulation of anesthesiologist assistants.

SB 717

Requires specified health care professional training programs to include in required curricula training on standardize clinical breast examinations.

SB 722

Directs Oregon Health Authority to conduct study assessing activities related to human papillomavirus and to prepa human papillomavirus and related cancer comprehensive control plan.
