- SB 21 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
Requires Department of Human Services to develop plan for long term care.
- SB 450 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
Establishes Task Force on the Delivery of Human Services.

Public Hearing

- SB 725
Specifies terms for contracts entered into between Oregon Health Authority and coordinated care organizations.

Public Hearing and Possible Work Session

- SB 304
Directs that Department of Human Services and court place child or ward with available nonrelated foster parent if home study conducted on nonrelated foster parent finds no evidence of unsuitability.
- SB 802
Provides that institution or program accredited by Commission on Dental Accreditation of American Dental Association does not need to name actively licensed dentist as dental director of dental offices or clinics owned or operated by institution or program.
