SB 4 **

**Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

Appropriates moneys to Department of Human Services to provide mental health and addiction services to seniors and persons with disabilities.

SB 823 **

**Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

Requires Oregon Health Authority to create new programs and expand existing programs to increase capacity statewide to provide mental health services and serve individuals with mental illness.

SB 382

Directs Department of Consumer and Business Services and Oregon Health Authority to jointly develop form that providers in this state may use to request prior authorization for prescription drug benefits.

SB 806

Authorizes individual licensed to practice medicine or podiatry in another state or country to provide health care services for out-of-state athletic team under certain circumstances.
