SB 382

CARRIED OVER FROM 4/9/13 AGENDA: Directs Department of Consumer and Business Services and Oregon Health Authority to jointly develop form that providers in this state may use to request prior authorization for prescription drug benefits.

SB 823 **

**Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

CARRIED OVER FROM 4/9/13 AGENDA: Requires Oregon Health Authority to create new programs and expand existing programs to increase capacity statewide to provide mental health services and serve individuals wit mental illness.

HB 2896

Possible Reconsideration of Amendment

Prohibits entity doing business in this state as tanning facility from allowing person who is under 18 years of age to use tanning device that is owned or operated by entity.

SB 123

Requires Department of Human Services to adopt rules to establish Oregon Foster Children's Bill of Rights.

SB 136

Provides that Oregon State Board of Nursing may authorize certified registered nurse anesthetists to write prescriptions and dispense prescription drugs.

SB 460

Restricts substitution of biosimilar product for prescribed biological product.

SB 569

Requires Oregon Health Authority to adopt uniform credentialing and privileging standards for providers of telemedicine services.

SB 722

Directs Oregon Health Authority to conduct study assessing activities related to human papillomavirus and to prepa human papillomavirus and related cancer comprehensive control plan.
