Work Session

- SB 123
Requires Department of Human Services to adopt rules to establish Oregon Foster Children's Bill of Rights.
- SB 136
Provides that Oregon State Board of Nursing may authorize certified registered nurse anesthetists to write prescriptions and dispense prescription drugs.
- SB 304
Directs that Department of Human Services and court place child or ward with available nonrelated foster parent if home study conducted on nonrelated foster parent finds no evidence of unsuitability.
- SB 460
Restricts substitution of biosimilar product for prescribed biological product.
- SB 569
Requires Oregon Health Authority to adopt uniform credentialing and privileging standards for providers of telemedicine services.
- SB 722
Directs Oregon Health Authority to conduct study assessing activities related to human papillomavirus and to prepare human papillomavirus and related cancer comprehensive control plan.

Public Hearing and Possible Work Session

- SB 457
Requires Oregon Health Authority to report to Seventy-eighth Legislative Assembly on changes necessary to implement federal health care law.
