Work Session

- SB 164
Requires Oregon Health Authority, with advice of Pharmacy and Therapeutics Committee, to adopt by rule conduct and communication standards for academic detailing.
- SB 379
Limits patient data that must be reported to Oregon Health Authority by providers of mental health and addiction services.
- SB 122
Authorizes Director of Department of Consumer and Business Services to adopt rules prohibiting or limiting coverage by health benefit plans of items, services or medical technologies pursuant to guidance by Health Evidence Review Commission.
- SB 604
Requires Oregon Medical Board to establish database for purpose of providing to credentialing organizations information that is necessary to credential persons regulated by board.
- SB 608
Requires Department of Consumer and Business Services to adopt form and standards for enrollee to claim reimbursement of out-of-network provider charges paid by enrollee.
- SB 363
Prohibits pharmacy benefit manager from creating administrative or financial incentives to encourage insureds to obtain prescription drugs from mail order pharmacy instead of retail pharmacy.
- SB 402
Specifies requirements for reimbursement of covered drugs by pharmacy benefit manager.

Requires Oregon Health Authority to create new programs and expand existing programs to increase capacity statewide to provide mental health services and serve individuals with mental illness. **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
