#### **Public Hearing and Possible Work Session**

HB 2102

Modifies provisions related to athletic trainer registration.

HB 2104 A

Revises definition of "medical imaging" to include medical imaging procedures not related to clinical diagnosis and treatment.

HB 2280

For community-based health care improvement program, modifies definition of "qualified employer" and authorized continuation coverage for employee who was enrolled in program and whose employment terminates.

HB 2612 A

Provides that postpartum mother may remove placenta from health care facility pursuant to rules adopted by Oregon Health Authority.

HB 2678 A

Authorizes person licensed in practice of physical therapy in another jurisdiction to provide physical therapy service to individual employed by or affiliated with touring theater company, performing arts company, athletic team or athletic organization.

HB 2992 A

Authorizes Oregon Health Authority to operate Farm Direct Nutrition Program to enable participants in Women, Infants and Children Program to purchase fresh produce at farmers' markets or roadside stands and to operate Senio Farm Direct Nutrition Program to enable low income seniors to purchase fresh produce at farmers' markets or roadside stands.

Requires insurer that provides coverage of ambulance care and transportation to indemnify provider of ambulance c and transportation directly.
