HB 2124 A

Eliminates from impaired health professional program requirement that employers of program participants establish minimum training requirements for supervisors of participants.

HB 2128 A

Requires Oregon Health Insurance Exchange Corporation and Oregon Educators Benefit Board to reach agreement plans offered through exchange to educators.

HB 2385

Removes, from health insurance coverage requirements for chemical dependency and mental or nervous conditions, exemption for treatment resulting from conviction of driving while under influence of intoxicants.

HB 3474 A

Allows student or parent or legal guardian of student to request in writing that student not participate in mental heal screening conducted for all students in specified grade or classroom.
