SB 184 **

CARRIED OVER FROM THE 2/5/2013 AGENDA - Allows notice of garnishment to be served by first class mail or, in certain circumstances, by other methods.

SB 53

Modifies authority granted to peace officers to perform community caretaking functions.

SB 93

Authorizes Department of Corrections to make grants to counties for provision of reentry support and services to certain offenders under 19 years of age.

SB 187

Modifies time period within which Department of Corrections must comply with court's direction to prepare certain proposed release plans.
