Possible Introduction of Committee Measures

Public Hearing and Possible Work Session

- SB 9
Provides that violation of offense of operating motor vehicle while using mobile communication device is Class B traffic violation instead of Class D traffic violation.
- SB 69
Modifies sentence that court is required to impose when certain persons are convicted of felony driving under the influence of intoxicants.
- SB 70
Eliminates July 1, 2013, sunset of provision that limits length of incarceration court may impose when certain probationary sentences are revoked for reasons other than commission of new crime.
- SB 92
Increases maximum penalty when certain crimes are committed against judicial officer and are related to officer's official duties.
