#### **Public Hearing and Possible Work Session**

SB 88

Requires superintendent of state mental hospital or director of facility to give notice to district attorney and counsel for defendant of court's determination that defendant lacks substantial probability of having capacity to stand trial or that defendant is entitled to discharge.

SB 89

Requires superintendent of state mental hospital or director of facility to evaluate defendant for capacity to stand tria if district attorney intends to file charges against defendant after defendant is discharged by court order.

SB 421

Authorizes district attorney to initiate commitment proceeding when person charged with certain crimes lacks capac to stand trial and is dangerous and in need of commitment.

SB 426

Increases from 180 days to two years maximum period of indefinite commitment of persons who lack capacity to stand trial due to mental illness and have been charged with certain crimes.
