#### Possible Introduction of Committee Measures

##### Public Hearing and Possible Work Session

- SB 589  
CARRIED OVER FROM THE 3/06/2013 AGENDA - Removes requirement that court review and approve administrative order for child support that modifies court order for child support.
- SB 590  
CARRIED OVER FROM THE 3/06/2013 AGENDA - Deletes requirement to provide telephone numbers in request for modification of child support orders.
- SB 591  
CARRIED OVER FROM THE 3/06/2013 AGENDA - Provides that entry of general judgment of dismissal of judicial proceeding does not dismiss previously entered administrative order of child support involving same parties
- SB 90  
Modifies certification system for shorthand reporters.
- SB 635  
Requires judge to appoint certified shorthand reporter for aggravated murder proceedings.

##### Work Session

- SB 49  
Authorizes Chief Justice of Supreme Court to adopt standards and plan for physical security of judges and staff.
- SB 51  
Streamlines consolidation of probation violation proceedings.
- SB 141  
Permits Secretary of State to disclose information concerning business registration transaction in order to assist with criminal investigation or prosecution at request of certain criminal justice agencies.
- SB 444  
Creates offense of smoking in motor vehicle.
