Possible Introduction of Committee Measures

Public Hearing and Possible Work Session

- SB 46
Requires action against person registered to practice architecture, landscape architecture or engineering arising out of construction, alteration or repair of improvement to real property to be commenced within six years after substantial completion or abandonment of construction, alteration or repair, regardless of date of discovery of damage or injury
- SB 479
Provides that State of Oregon does not have ownership interest in certain real property.
- SB 480
Modifies requirement that attorney for person asserting claim against construction design professional certify that witness construction design professional is available and willing to testify in favor of claimant.

Work Session

- SB 52
Directs state agencies to preserve final orders issued by agency in digital format and to provide electronic copies to Oregon State Bar, or designee, upon request.
- SB 528
Allows Secretary of State, State Treasurer, judicial department and legislative department to obtain copyrights and patents on data processing materials and to sell, lease or otherwise make available the materials to state and federal governmental bodies.
- SB 565
Modifies authority of Oregon Health and Science University to establish police force.
