##### Public Hearing and Possible Work Session

- SB 71  
CARRIED OVER FROM THE 3/20/2013 AGENDA **For the purposes of hearing testimony from Darrel Fuller Kevin Campbell, Roger Beyer, Becky Straus, and Gail Meyer : Imposes restrictions on use of drones by private parties and public entities.**
- SB 680  
Provides that certain persons may seek contribution from persons who have resolved liability to state in administrative or judicially approved settlement.
- SB 709  
Allows person holding interest in property to recover economic and property damages resulting from fire occurring due to certain statutory or rule violations or resulting from fire escaping from land used or capable of being used for growing forest tree species.

##### Work Session

- SB 90  
Modifies certification system for shorthand reporters.
- SB 635  
Requires judge to appoint certified shorthand reporter for aggravated murder proceedings.
- SB 638  
Approves adoption of and modifications to rules of Oregon Criminal Justice Commission.
