#### Possible Introduction of Committee Measures

##### Public Hearing and Possible Work Session

- SB 125 A  
Requires state agency to provide notice to parties in contested case hearing describing rights that active duty servicemembers have to stay proceedings under federal law and providing contact information for legal resources.
- SB 180 \*\*  
Reduces portion of fine imposed in criminal action that is payable to state. **\*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means**
- SB 188  
Authorizes Oregon Youth Authority to establish work release program for persons in physical custody of youth authority but in legal custody of Department of Corrections.
- SB 281  
Adds post-traumatic stress disorder to definition of "debilitating medical condition" for purposes of statutes authorizing medical use of marijuana.
- SJR 34 \*\*  
Proposes amendment to Oregon Constitution to allow person serving as judge to be employed by Oregon National Guard for purpose of performing military service or by State Board of Higher Education or school board for purposes of teaching. **\*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Rules**

#### Work Session

- SB 71  
Imposes restrictions on use of drones by private parties and public entities.
