#### Possible Introduction of Committee Measures

##### Public Hearing and Possible Work Session

- SB 566  
Directs State Medical Examiner to assume counties' responsibilities related to death investigations.
- SB 623  
Revises and clarifies requirements for petition to adopt minor child.
- SB 812  
Provides that party or attorney may make no more than one motion for change of judge in cause, matter or proceeding in judicial district with three or fewer circuit court judges.

##### Work Session

- SB 6  
Increases punishment for animal neglect in first degree to maximum of five years' imprisonment, \$125,000 fine, or both, and, for repeat animal neglect offenders or animal neglect offenses involving 10 or more animals, to maximum of 10 years' imprisonment, \$250,000 fine, or both.
- SB 396  
Exempts from execution debtor's right to assets held in, or right to receive payments under, medical savings account or health savings account.
- SB 463  
Requires Oregon Criminal Justice Commission to create, upon request of member of Legislative Assembly, racial and ethnic impact statement for proposed legislation or state measure.
