Public Hearing and Possible Work Session

SB 815

Provides that agri-tourism provider is not liable for injury to or death of participant arising out of inherent risks of agri-tourism activities if agri-tourism provider posts certain notices.

SB 798

Allows court to replace juror with alternate juror in criminal case after jury begins deliberations in certain circumstances.

SB 799

Requires order of court to change attorney, or to terminate relationship of attorney and client, in action or proceedin

Work Session

SB 6

Increases punishment for animal neglect in first degree to maximum of five years' imprisonment, \$125,000 fine, or both, and, for repeat animal neglect offenders or animal neglect offenses involving 10 or more animals, to maximum of 10 years' imprisonment, \$250,000 fine, or both.

SB 46

Requires action against person registered to practice architecture, landscape architecture or engineering arising out construction, alteration or repair of improvement to real property to be commenced within six years after substantial completion or abandonment of construction, alteration or repair, regardless of date of discovery of damage or injury
