SB 622
Defines "record of the case" and "supplemental confidential file" in juvenile court proceedings.

Work Session

SB 71
Imposes restrictions on use of drones by private parties and public entities.

SB 347
Modifies crime applicable to possession of firearm, or instrument used as dangerous weapon, while in or on school grounds.

SB 699 **
Modifies laws prohibiting possession of firearms in public buildings. **Subsequent Referral(s) to Rules

SB 700
Requires person to request criminal background check before transferring firearm to any other person outside the transferor's immediate family.

SB 780
Requires grand jury proceeding involving use of deadly force by police officer to be recorded, transcribed and made available to public.

SB 796
Requires person applying for concealed handgun license to pass firing range test.
