Public Hearing and Possible Work Session

- SB 834
Increases penalty for crime of initiating false report to maximum of one year's imprisonment, \$6,250 fine, or both.
- SB 851
Directs Public Utility Commission to appoint executive director of Oregon Board of Maritime Pilots.

Work Session

- SB 6
Increases punishment for animal neglect in first degree to maximum of five years' imprisonment, \$125,000 fine, or both, and, for repeat animal neglect offenders or animal neglect offenses involving 10 or more animals, to maximum of 10 years' imprisonment, \$250,000 fine, or both.
- SB 54
Defines "digital accounts" and "digital assets" for purposes of administration of estates and trusts.
- SB 90
Modifies certification system for shorthand reporters.
- SB 492
Requires district attorney to disclose to defendant data, documents, tangible objects or information that reasonably appears to be favorable to defendant with respect to determination of guilt, preliminary matter or sentence to be imposed.
- SB 566
Directs State Medical Examiner to assume counties' responsibilities related to death investigations.
- SB 635
Requires judge to appoint certified shorthand reporter for aggravated murder proceedings.
- SB 610
Modifies types of conditions qualifying as disability and types of animals qualifying as assistance animals for purposes of accessing places of public accommodation and places of access to state government services, programs activities and for purposes of cause of action for harm to assistance animal.
- SB 799
Requires order of court to change attorney, or to terminate relationship of attorney and client, in action or proceeding

SB 798

Allows court to replace juror with alternate juror in criminal case after jury begins deliberations in certain circumstances.
