Public Hearing and Possible Work Session

- SB 68
Eliminates mandatory minimum sentence for persons under 18 years of age convicted of committing crime of using child in a display of sexually explicit conduct.
- SB 180 **
Reduces portion of fine imposed in criminal action that is payable to state. **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
- SB 622
Defines "record of the case" and "supplemental confidential file" in juvenile court proceedings.
- SB 696
Modifies exemption from execution applicable to certain firearms.
- SB 713
Permits firearms training facilities in exclusive farm use zones.

Work Session

- SB 71
Imposes restrictions on use of drones by private parties and public entities.
- SB 125 A
Requires state agency to provide notice to parties in contested case hearing describing rights that active duty servicemembers have to stay proceedings under federal law and providing contact information for legal resources.
- SB 780
Requires grand jury proceeding involving use of deadly force by police officer to be recorded, transcribed and made available to public.
