### **Public Hearing and Possible Work Session**

SB 68

Eliminates mandatory minimum sentence for persons under 18 years of age convicted of committing crime of using child in a display of sexually explicit conduct.

SB 180

Reduces portion of fine imposed in criminal action that is payable to state.

SB 622

Defines "record of the case" and "supplemental confidential file" in juvenile court proceedings.

SB 696

Modifies exemption from execution applicable to certain firearms.

Amendment to be considered: SB 696-1 which prohibits a person from obtaining a concealed handgun permi person has been convicted of a misdemeanor crime involving domestic violence consistent with federal law th prohibits a person with a misdemeanor domestic violence conviction from possessing a firearm. Prohibits a person obtaining a concealed firearm permit if subject to a restraining order from another state or a restraining elderly or child abuse. Allows a person to obtain a concealed handgun permit with only one conviction for misdemeanor or violation conviction for possession of marijuana or who completed a diversion program for marijuana possession.

SB 713

Permits firearms training facilities in exclusive farm use zones.

### Work Session

SB 71

Imposes restrictions on use of drones by private parties and public entities.

SB 125 A

Requires state agency to provide notice to parties in contested case hearing describing rights that active duty servicemembers have to stay proceedings under federal law and providing contact information for legal resources.
