Public Hearing and Possible Work Session

HB 2049

Authorizes juvenile community supervision officer to take youth offender who violates parole into custody upon issuance of order or warrant of arrest.

HB 2053

Authorizes requests by certain state agencies for criminal records checks for purposes of licensure, certification or registration of foster homes by Native American tribes.

HB 2143 A

Eliminates requirement that Department of Corrections inspect local correctional facility of county for compliance with specified provisions of state law when county conducts inspections for compliance.

HB 2234

Eliminates sunset of provision authorizing supervisory authority to place offenders on inactive post-prison supervision.

HB 2378

Allows parent or guardian of minor to file petition seeking appointment of guardian for minor as adult within 90 days before minor attains majority or such other time as court deems necessary and appropriate.

HB 2433 A

Prohibits court from considering party's disability in determining child custody unless court finds behaviors or limitations related to party's disability endanger or will endanger health, safety or welfare of child.
