HB 2111 A

Revises standard for determination of whether individual is substantially limited in major life activity.

HB 2562 A

Allows Chief Justice of Supreme Court to adopt rules governing use of electronic applications for all state court records and for transmission of jury information to circuit courts.

HB 2570 A

Provides that funds of person subject to protective proceeding may be used to pay reasonable fees, costs and disbursements for services related to protective proceeding.

HB 2573 A

Provides that engaging in business of or acting in capacity of immigration consultant is unlawful practice subject to enforcement under Unlawful Trade Practices Act unless federal law authorizes person to act as immigration consultant or person is active member of Oregon State Bar.
