HB 2542

Increases period of revocation of driving privileges to three years if person convicted of failure to perform duties of driver causes serious physical injury to another.

HB 2773

Permits person to enter into driving while under influence of intoxicants diversion agreement even if person has already entered treatment following charge of minor in possession of alcoholic beverage or charge of possession of less than one ounce of marijuana.

HB 3198

Requires justice or municipal court to notify Department of State Police when court enters judgment of conviction c Class A misdemeanor.

HB 3253 A

Requires sex offender who is released into Oregon, who is placed on probation in Oregon or who moves into Oregon, to register as sex offender if jurisdiction of conviction requires registration, regardless of whether convictio would be sex crime in this state.

HB 3281

Requires all agents of defense to inform victim of right to refuse contact in criminal and post-conviction proceeding
