HB 2433 A

Prohibits court from considering party's disability in determining child custody unless court finds behaviors or limitations related to party's disability endanger or will endanger health, safety or welfare of child.

HB 2571

Clarifies that spousal support payments terminate on death of either party in domestic relations proceeding.

HB 2572

Allows court to order payment of attorney fees, costs and expenses in domestic relations proceeding that relates to life insurance.

HB 2603 A

Provides that if motion is filed for return or restoration of device seized by law enforcement agency as gray machine burden of proof is on state to establish that device is gray machine.

HB 2685

Authorizes temporary release of inmates conveyed to another jurisdiction on same terms as inmates confined in Department of Corrections institution.

Repeals sunset on Task Force on Victims' Rights Enforcement.

HB 3278

Permits appellate court to vacate juvenile court judgment or order and remand to juvenile court for reconsideration.
