#### **Public Hearing and Possible Work Session**

HB 2116 A

Authorizes court to provide medical exemption to person otherwise required to install ignition interlock device as pa of driving while under influence of intoxicants diversion agreement if person meets requirements established by Department of Transportation by rule.

HB 2601 A

Modifies restriction on use of photographs taken using photo red light camera.

HB 3253 A

Requires sex offender who is released into Oregon, who is placed on probation in Oregon or who moves into Oregon, to register as sex offender if jurisdiction of conviction requires registration, regardless of whether convictio would be sex crime in this state.

HB 3467 A

Requires persons that operate websites that disseminate photographic records of arrested individuals and charge fee for removal of these records to remove photographs and related information from all websites within their ownershi or control without charging fee when requested in writing and arrest resulted in acquittal or violation, or following expunction.

HB 3277 A

Allows prosecuting attorneys 90 days after sentencing to present restitution information to court.
