Public Hearing and Possible Work Session

- HB 2384 A
CARRIED OVER FROM THE 5/28/2013 AGENDA - Authorizes civil and criminal forfeiture of motor vehicle if person is convicted of certain offenses relating to driving while suspended or revoked.
- HB 3327 A
CARRIED OVER FROM THE 5/28/2013 AGENDA - Authorizes court to set aside conviction for certain sex crimes under certain circumstances.

Work Session

- HB 2536 A
Modifies laws relating to transfers of structured settlement payment rights.
- HB 2562 A
Allows Chief Justice of Supreme Court to adopt rules governing use of electronic applications for all state court records and for transmission of jury information to circuit courts.
- HB 2668
Expands definition of "place of public accommodation" to include places owned or maintained by public body and services provided by public body.
- HB 2710
Provides that drone may be used by law enforcement agency for purpose of surveillance of person only pursuant to warrant or in emergency circumstances.
- HB 2962 A
CARRIED OVER FROM THE 5/28/2013 AGENDA - Repeals statute requiring trial within reasonable period of time for criminal defendants.
- HB 3253 A
CARRIED OVER FROM THE 5/28/2013 AGENDA - Requires sex offender who is released into Oregon, who is placed on probation in Oregon or who moves into Oregon, to register as sex offender if jurisdiction of conviction requires registration, regardless of whether conviction would be sex crime in this state.
