SB 465

Allows local government with land use jurisdiction over residential improvements substantially damaged by flooding to cause to be recorded, in office of county clerk, official designation of substantial damage.

SB 578 **

**Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

Prohibits harvesting of wild mushrooms without wild mushroom harvesting permit.

SB 715 **

**Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

Requires harvesting in areas of Tillamook State Forest and Clatsop State Forest exhibiting moderate to extreme occurrence of Swiss needle cast disease.
