Possible Introduction of Committee Measures

Public Hearing

- SB 173 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
Creates service delivery technical assistance program in Governor's office to provide assistance to counties in fiscal distress.
- SB 582
Revises language regarding Department of Consumer and Business Services assumption of administration and enforcement of county manufactured dwelling services, building inspection program or part of building inspection program if county ceases administration and enforcement due to budget limitations resulting from reduction or elimination of federal payments made to offset lost county timber harvest revenue from federal forestlands.

Public Hearing and Work Session

- SB 581
Extends sunset date for provisions of law relating to county in fiscal distress and fiscal assistance board statutes.

Work Session

- SB 465
Allows local government with land use jurisdiction over residential improvements substantially damaged by flooding to cause to be recorded, in office of county clerk, official designation of substantial damage.
- SB 677
Creates exception to requirement that wages due to seasonal farmworker must be paid immediately after termination of employment.
- SB 719
Changes basis and permissible scope of assessments by Oregon Sheep Commission.
