CARRIED OVER FROM THE 3-21-2013 AGENDA: Changes basis and permissible scope of assessments by Oregon Sheep Commission.
- SB 245 \*\* \*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Finance and Revenue  
Authorizes designation of enterprise zone and zone and city for electronic commerce, addition of zone cosponsor and change of enterprise zone boundary without application process, subject to determination by Oregon Business Development Department that certain statutory requirements met.

**Public Hearing and Possible Work Session**

- SB 580  
Prescribes duties for specified scientific and technical advisory committee and gives committee authority to select members.
- SB 605 \*\* \*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means  
Establishes Federal Ocean Resources Fund.

**Public Hearing**

- SB 359  
Exempts wave energy facility or project in territorial sea from licensing process for hydroelectric facilities if wave energy facility or project is subject to project review and approval by Land Conservation and Development Commission for compliance with Oregon Ocean Resources Management Program and Coastal Zone Management Act of 1972.
