Possible Introduction of Committee Measures

Work Session

- SB 250
Authorizes local government required to have urban growth boundary to include land within boundary when inclusion of land is consistent with local economic development projections and public facilities plans.
- SB 462
Provides that composting facility that composts certain type of feedstocks may not be located within specified distance of boundary of incorporated city.
- SB 582
Revises language regarding Department of Consumer and Business Services assumption of administration and enforcement of county manufactured dwelling services, building inspection program or part of building inspection program if county ceases administration and enforcement due to budget limitations resulting from reduction or elimination of federal payments made to offset lost county timber harvest revenue from federal forestlands.
- SB 606 **
Requires owners and operators of wave energy facilities and devices to remove equipment related to wave energy facilities and devices within certain period. **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
- SB 737 **
Establishes Oregon Ocean Work Group for purpose of adopting Nearshore Strategic Plan. **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
- SB 841
Allows winery to be sited on land zoned for mixed farm and forest use.
