Possible Introduction of Committee Measures

Public Hearing and Possible Work Session

SB 250

Authorizes local government required to have urban growth boundary to include land within boundary when inclusion of land is consistent with local economic development projections and public facilities plans.

SB 538

Allows two or more counties to petition Land Conservation and Development Commission to establish by rule regional definitions for "agricultural land" and "forestland" for purposes of land use planning in proposed region.

Work Session

SB 19

Amends definition of "rural area" to mean area outside urban growth boundary as boundary is acknowledged on date on which application is submitted for strategic investment program.

SB 77

Requires appellate review of quasi-judicial land use decisions and limited land use decisions directly related to and made in response to land use application to be conducted in single proceeding in which Land Use Board of Appeals has joined all appeals.

SB 606 **

Requires owners and operators of wave energy facilities and devices to remove equipment related to wave energy facilities and devices within certain period.

SB 737 **

Establishes Oregon Ocean Work Group for purpose of adopting Nearshore Strategic Plan.

**Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

SB 841

Allows winery to be sited on land zoned for mixed farm and forest use.
