Possible Introduction of Committee Measures

Public Hearing and Work Session

SB 773

Prohibits city or district from requiring landowner to consent to eventual annexation in exchange for continuation of extraterritorial service originally provided to landowner or predecessor in interest of landowner without requiring consent to annexation.

Work Session

SJM 10

Urges Congress to transfer management of Oregon and California Railroad grant lands to newly established board of trustees consisting of representatives from local government, environmental organizations and timber industry.

SB 257 **

**Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

Creates fund to allow State Board of Forestry to issue loans to United States Forest Service to prepare for and conduct sale of forest products to be harvested from federal forestlands within state.

SB 357

Establishes policy direction for management of state forestlands, including management for timber harvesting.

SB 462

Provides that composting facility that composts certain type of feedstocks may not be located within specified distance of boundary of incorporated city.

SB 582

Revises language regarding Department of Consumer and Business Services assumption of administration and enforcement of county manufactured dwelling services, building inspection program or part of building inspection program if county ceases administration and enforcement due to budget limitations resulting from reduction or elimination of federal payments made to offset lost county timber harvest revenue from federal forestlands.

SB 708

Prohibits city incorporated after January 1, 1982, from processing land use applications and from making land use decisions and limited land use decisions when city has not caused comprehensive plan and land use regulations to be acknowledged within four years after date of incorporation.
