- SB 149
Updates laws related to ballots for absent electors.
- SB 268 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
Allows amounts contributed for employee by State Board of Higher Education or Oregon Health and Science University Board of Directors for supplemental retirement benefits to be transferred to Public Employees Retirement Fund to offset liabilities for employer contributions of board if employee separates from service of board before certain period elapses.
- SB 269 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
Modifies provisions relating to Optional Retirement Plan for administrative and academic employees of Oregon University System.
- SB 320 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Tax Credits
Extends sunset of income tax credit for political contributions through tax years beginning before January 1, 2020.
