#### Public Hearing and Possible Work Session

- SB 145  
Expands definition of "petition committee" to include combination of two or more individuals, or person other than individual, who receives contribution or makes expenditure for purpose of supporting or opposing initiative, referendum or recall petition.
- SB 147  
Adjusts deadlines for filing portrait and statement of candidate in voters' pamphlet and deadline for filing signatures in lieu of voters' pamphlet fees.
- SB 148  
Requires chief petitioners to perform criminal records checks on paid circulators.
- SB 154  
Requires organization or entity that pays persons to obtain signatures on election petitions to register with Secretary of State.
- SB 158  
Allows use of proceeds from legal expense trust fund to pay expenses incurred by public official in connection with Oregon State Bar disciplinary proceedings.
- HB 2079 A  
Standardizes definitions of "member of the household" and "relative" for purposes of government ethics laws.
- HB 2080  
Modifies language relating to imposition of civil penalties for government ethics violations under Administrative Procedures Act.
