SB 150

Increases maximum civil penalty for violations of election law or rule.

SB 789

Clarifies that only certain districts claiming exception from requirement to offer benefits provided and administered by Oregon Educators Benefit Board must undergo actuarial analysis by board to maintain exception.

Public Hearing and Possible Work Session

SB 844

For the purpose of considering the -3 amendments

Directs Public Utility Commission to establish voluntary greenhouse gas emission reduction program for purposes of incentivizing public utilities to invest in projects that reduce greenhouse gas emissions and providing benefits to customers of public utilities.

SJR 1

For the purpose of considering the -5 amendments

Proposes amendment to Oregon Constitution to allow indebtedness to finance corpus of Oregon Student Opportunity Fund.

HB 3434

For the purpose of considering the -2 amendments

Defines "within 1,000 feet" as straight line measurement in radius extending 1,000 feet or less in every direction from a specified location or from boundary line of property for purposes of determining whether certain activities and operations are unlawful.
