Work Session

SB 789

Clarifies that only certain districts claiming exception from requirement to offer benefits provided and administered by Oregon Educators Benefit Board must undergo actuarial analysis by board to maintain exception.

HB 2199 A

Requires elections officials to follow certain security procedures relating to ballots.

Public Hearing and Possible Work Session

SB 414 A

Permits Director of Department of Consumer and Business Services to seek restitution on behalf of consumer that suffered actual damages as result of insurer's violation of Insurance Code or breach of insurance contract or policy and to seek other equitable relief that director deems appropriate under circumstances.

HB 2233 A

Modifies laws governing seizure of abandoned vessels.

HB 3294 A

Exempts electronic mail addresses in possession or custody of executive department, local government, local service district or special government body from required disclosure under public records law, except for electronic mail addresses assigned by public body to public employees for use in ordinary course of employment.
