HB 2672 B

Establishes certain workplace protections for domestic workers.

Public Hearing and Work Session

SB 805

Permits employee of contracting agency that conducts cost analysis or determines feasibility of procurement, or exclusive representative of employee's bargaining unit, to seek judicial review of cost analysis or determination.

HB 2747 A

For the purpose of considering the -A7 amendments

Describes student characteristics that district school board that admits nonresident students by giving consent or that charges nonresident students tuition is prohibited from considering when determining whether to give consent or accept nonresident student or when establishing terms of consent or amount of tuition.

HB 2206 A

Authorizes county to request declaration by Governor of emergency in county that is conducting elections at less than minimally adequate level.

HB 3389 A

Prohibits beneficiary from requiring as condition of short sale, except in certain circumstances, that nonprofit entity that purchases property in short sale, or that purchases note from beneficiary, enter into agreement with beneficiary grantor that limits or bars grantor from owning or occupying residential property after short sale or sale of note.

HB 3404

Permits counties, under certain conditions, to receive assistance payments from County Assessment Function Funding Assistance Account for 2013-2014 and 2014-2015 fiscal years that do not reflect changes in federal payments to county.
