SB 845

Authorizes Governor and Director of the Department of Land Conservation and Development to exempt certain land use decisions from appeal by contract with member of traded sector industry that agrees to acquire and develop large-site industrial use employing at least 500 full-time employees.

HB 3162 B

Requires Oregon Health Authority to maintain list of designated high priority chemicals of concern for children's health used in children's products.

HR 3316 R

Requires Secretary of State to conduct performance audit of Tri-County Metropolitan Transportation District of Oregon.

HB 3460 A

Directs Oregon Health Authority to establish registration system for medical marijuana facilities for transferring usable marijuana from registry identification cardholders, designated primary caregivers of registry identification cardholders or marijuana grow sites to medical marijuana facilities and from medical marijuana facilities to registry identification cardholders or designated primary caregivers of registry identification cardholders.
