Public Hearing

- SB 1
Requires employer to provide paid or unpaid time off for Veterans Day to employees who are veterans.
- SJM 1 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Judiciary
Urges Congress to develop mechanisms that provide adequate notice to states in which persons convicted in military courts of sex crimes plan to reside.
- SB 45 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Judiciary
Requires state agencies to notify parties in contested case hearing of rights that active duty servicemembers have to stay proceedings under federal law.
- SB 124 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Judiciary
Directs court to consider evidence received during criminal proceeding regarding defendant's status as servicemember in determining aggravation or mitigation.
- SB 125 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Judiciary
Requires state agency to provide notice to parties in contested case hearing describing rights that active duty servicemembers have to stay proceedings under federal law.
