##### Public Hearing

- SB 133 \*\* \*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Tax Credits  
Allows credit against income taxes for employment of qualified military veterans.
- SB 461 \*\* \*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Business and Transportation  
Provides that Interstate 84 in Oregon shall be known as Vietnam Veterans Memorial Highway.

##### Work Session

- SB 1  
Requires employer to provide paid or unpaid time off for Veterans Day to employees who are veterans.
- SJM 1 \*\* \*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Judiciary  
Urges Congress to develop mechanisms that provide adequate notice to states in which persons convicted in military courts of sex crimes plan to reside.
- SB 124 \*\* \*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Judiciary  
Directs court to consider evidence received during criminal proceeding regarding defendant's status as servicemember in determining aggravation or mitigation.
