Requires state agency to provide notice to parties in contested case hearing describing rights that active duty servicemembers have to stay proceedings under federal law.
- SB 461 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Business and Transportation
Provides that Interstate 84 in Oregon shall be known as Vietnam Veterans Memorial Highway.
