- SB 34  
Removes limit on number of loans eligible individual may receive or assume from Department of Veterans' Affairs.
- SB 35  
Modifies limit on amount of home and farm loans made by Department of Veterans' Affairs.
- SB 36  
Makes state financial aid to veterans for educational purposes subject to available funds.
- HB 2633  
Defines "honorable conditions" with regard to honorable discharge status of veteran as having meaning given in rule adopted by Department of Veterans' Affairs.

- SB 125 \*\*  
CARRIED OVER FROM THE 2/21/2013 AGENDA. Requires state agency to provide notice to parties in contested case hearing describing rights that active duty servicemembers have to stay proceedings under federal law  
\*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Judiciary
- SB 133 \*\*  
Allows credit against income taxes for employment of qualified military veterans.  
\*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Tax Credits
