- SB 665 \*\* \*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means  
Transfers State Interoperability Executive Council from Department of Transportation to Oregon Department of Administrative Services.
- HB 2182  
Designates September 27 as annual First Responder Appreciation Day.
- HB 2183  
Eliminates requirement that annual earthquake drills be conducted by employers in month of April.

- SB 125 \*\* \*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Judiciary  
CARRIED OVER FROM 02-28-2013 MEETING. Requires state agency to provide notice to parties in contested case hearing describing rights that active duty servicemembers have to stay proceedings under federal law.
- SB 133 \*\* \*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Tax Credits  
CARRIED OVER FROM 02-28-2013 MEETING. Allows credit against income taxes for employment of qualified military veterans.
- SB 32  
Establishes Oregon Code of Military Justice as law governing state militia.
- SB 33  
Modifies list of state agencies required to designate liaison for emergency preparedness and response.
- SB 97  
Changes name of Oregon Pre-Disaster Mitigation Fund to Oregon Emergency Preparedness Account.
- SCR 9  
In memoriam: Andrew Keller, 1989-2012.
- HCR 3  
Recognizes Korean veterans for their service during Vietnam War.

HB 2633

Defines "honorable conditions" with regard to honorable discharge status of veteran as having meaning given in rule adopted by Department of Veterans' Affairs.
