Public Hearing

HB 2034

Authorizes Office of Emergency Management, which is sole agency of state for negotiating agreements with Department of Homeland Security, to cooperate with tribal governments for purpose of acquiring and coordinating use of federal funds for emergency program management and emergency services in state.

HB 2044

Removes limit on compensation for ordinary services after Department of Veterans' Affairs is appointed conservato HB 2046

Permits Director of Veterans' Affairs to retract waiver of claim against estate of person under certain circumstances.
