Public Hearing

HB 2708 A

Directs Department of Transportation to erect and maintain Fallen Hero roadside memorial sign for individuals killed in line of duty or who died as result of wounds received in action while serving in Armed Forces of United States.

HCR 23

Recognizes service and sacrifices of atomic veterans.

HCR 24

Expresses support for creation of Veterans Treatment Court in all judicial districts.

HJM 9

Urges Congress to change funding of veterans' health care from discretionary entitlement to permanent and direct entitlement.

HB 2044

Removes limit on compensation for ordinary services after Department of Veterans' Affairs is appointed conservator

HB 2046

Permits Director of Veterans' Affairs to retract waiver of claim against estate of person under certain circumstances.
