## Water Resources Agency Overview






- Mission: To serve the public by practicing and promoting responsible long-term water management.

# Water Resources Expenditure History/2013-15 Governor's Budget



### Revenue Sources: 2013 15 Governor's Budg








### **Agency Budget By Program** (in millions)
