The Gray Family Foundation is proud of Oregon's long history of valuing and caring for our state's fantastic natural resources and astounding natural beauty. John Gray was active in encouraging public understanding of Oregon's land use laws so that we could protect, manage, and use our lands in ways that provided benefit to all Oregonians.

We are worried, however, that Oregonians are in danger of losing their connection to our natural heritage because Outdoor School is fading away across the state.
