Measure Description:

Provides that physician or health care provider may at any time report to Department of Transportation that person's cognitive or functional impairment affects person's ability to safely operate motor vehicle, without regard to whether report is required by department.

Government Unit(s) Affected:

Oregon Department of Transportation (ODOT)

Analysis:
