


• Mission:



- Investments and other policy packages
 - General Fund: New debt service for service life extensions
 - 9-1-1 tax sunset extension
 - Three armory service life extension projects
 - Transfer of Seismic program to Business Development
 - Umatilla Army Depot caretaker contract
 - Kingsley Field firefighters
- Statewide adjustments: updates to DAS Price List and State Government Services Charges, placeholder for Statewide Administrative Savings, PERS Rate and PERS Policy adjustments

Oregon Military Department 2013-15 Governor's Budget/Revisions



- Seismic Rehab transfer package requires adjustment
- Shift a portion of the funding for 5 positions from Other Funds to Federal Funds in Package 304, "9-1-1 Fund Shift"
